## Guest at the bohemian nobility

## Highlights:

Stay in the Bohemian Forest National Park. Visit the UNESCO World Heritage Krumau, the beertown Budweis, the castle Hluboka, the monastery Hohenfurth, the Lipno Reservoir, Prachatice, the castle of Rabi and the palace of Welhartitz or alternatively Passau. You can meet a Czech healer. You will be taken to places of energy and you can expect a Bohemian live music and dance evening.

Day 1: Departure from Frankfurt/Main Central Station at 9 o'clock. We take the highway to Passau, pass through the Bavarian Forest and in the evening we reach our hotel in the Bohemian Forest. The hotel has a lounge, a sauna, a solarium, a fitness room, table tennis, bicycle rental and a bowling alley. You can contact a Czech healer for a consultation.

Day 2: 1<sup>st</sup> day-trip: Today we experience the city of Krumau on the river VItava, a Unesco World Heritage Site. We visit this medieval city and reach a point of geomagnetic force. In your free time it is possible to visit the castle on your own. In the afternoon we drive along the romantic VItava/Moldau River to Hohenfurth, where we visit the monastery of the Cistercians. In the evening we listen to a chapter from the Good Soldier Svejk by Hasek, which is set in this area.

Day 3: During our second day trip we visit Budweis and the Castle Hluboka, the former ancestral seat of the Schwarzenberg aristocracy. In Budweis we take a walk, ending on a serving of theleading to a brewery which will be serving us. Hluboka, also referred to as the Neuschwanstein Castle of Bohemia, is the third largest castle in Bohemia. You can explore the castle and the English park on your own. In the evening we listen to a text by the writer Adalbert Stifter.

Day 4: 3<sup>rd</sup> day-trip: Today you see Rabi, the largest castle in Bohemia, Sušice and Velhartice, a Gothic palace with a Renaissance castle. Alternatively, a trip to Passau will be offered with a walk through the baroque Old Town situated at the confluence of the rivers Danube, Inn and Iltz and the St. Stephen's Cathedral with the largest church organ in the world. In the evening here will be a Bohemian live music and dance event.

Day 5: Drive Trip back to Frankfurt/Main
