

Eight days trip into the heart of Poland

Highlights: Poznan, Palace Hotel Czerniejewo, visit Chopin in Zelazowa Wola, the old town of Warsaw, stalk through the Bialowierski jungle, canoe trip on the Narew, Mazury, organ concert in Swieta Lipka, Malbork, Gdansk, bathing in the Baltic Sea, Szczecin.

Day 1: Departure from Frankfurt/Main. In Frankfurt/ on Oder we reach Poland. For three nights we stay in the Palace Hotel Czerniejewo near Gniezno.

Day 2: Visit of the state stallion breeding station, followed by horse-drawn carriage ride. In the afternoon we visit Poznan, the fair and the lively university town.

Day 3: In the morning you have the opportunity of riding a horse- at your own risk; in the afternoon we visit Gniezno, once the first capital of Poland.

Day 4: On the way to Warsaw we visit Zelazowa Wola, the birthplace of Frederic Chopin and then the Old Town of Warsaw. In the evening we drive to Bialowieza at the Belarusian border.

Day 5: Today we go on an excursion including a picnic in the National park by bike or horse and carriage, and with some luck we will see wisents, the European bison.

Day 6: Canoe trip on the Narew: in the beautiful countryside we observe the rich variety of native birds.

Day 7: Our trip continues through Mazury, at the visiting the pilgrimage church Heilige Linde (Swieta Lipka), we listen to an organ recital. In the afternoon we reach the crusader castle Marienburg, where we stay overnight.

Day 8: After a walk through the Old Town of Gdansk we pass Oliwa on the way to the Baltic Sea, where we spend a day on the seaside. We stay overnight in Piaski Wielki, a former manor house of the noble family Flemming.

Day 9: Via Szczecin and Berlin we drive back to Frankfurt/Main
